Pali Text Society(PTS)は、1881年、パーリ語文献研究の振興促進を目的として、T.W. Rhys Davidsによって設立された協会です。パーリ語文献のローマ字版、英訳版、辞典や索引書、パーリ語文献に関する研究書、ジャーナルを出版しています。これまで数多くの古典文献や注釈書を刊行し、そのうちの多くは英訳されました。協会では、全ての出版物が常に入手可能であること、1年につき新刊本を少なくとも2部、ジャーナルを1部刊行することを目指しています。

PTSは非営利団体であり、出版物の販売、会費、寄付で運営されています。出版活動のほか、世界各国でパーリ語文献研究に携わる研究者たちを支援しています。また、東南アジアの写本の保存と識別のプロジェクト“Fragile Palm Leaves Project”を支援しています。
